### Present

<b>I</b>	grumble
<b>you</b>	grumble
<b>he/she/it</b>	grumbles
<b>we</b>	grumble
<b>you</b>	grumble
<b>they</b>	grumble

### Present continuous

<b>I</b>	am grumbling
<b>you</b>	are grumbling
<b>he/she/it</b>	is grumbling
<b>we</b>	are grumbling
<b>you</b>	are grumbling
<b>they</b>	are grumbling

### Simple past

<b>I</b>	grumbled
<b>you</b>	grumbled
<b>he/she/it</b>	grumbled
<b>we</b>	grumbled
<b>you</b>	grumbled
<b>they</b>	grumbled

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was grumbling
<b>you</b>	were grumbling
<b>he/she/it</b>	was grumbling
<b>we</b>	were grumbling
<b>you</b>	were grumbling
<b>they</b>	were grumbling

### Present perfect

<b>I</b>	have grumbled
<b>you</b>	have grumbled
<b>he/she/it</b>	has grumbled
<b>we</b>	have grumbled
<b>you</b>	have grumbled
<b>they</b>	have grumbled

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been grumbling
<b>you</b>	have been grumbling
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been grumbling
<b>we</b>	have been grumbling
<b>you</b>	have been grumbling
<b>they</b>	have been grumbling

### Past perfect

<b>I</b>	had grumbled
<b>you</b>	had grumbled
<b>he/she/it</b>	had grumbled
<b>we</b>	had grumbled
<b>you</b>	had grumbled
<b>they</b>	had grumbled

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been grumbling
<b>you</b>	had been grumbling
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been grumbling
<b>we</b>	had been grumbling

### Future

<b>I</b>	will grumble
<b>you</b>	will grumble
<b>he/she/it</b>	will grumble
<b>we</b>	will grumble

### Future continuous

<b>I</b>	will be grumbling
<b>you</b>	will be grumbling
<b>he/she/it</b>	will be grumbling

### Future perfect

<b>I</b>	will have grumbled
<b>you</b>	will have grumbled

### Conditional present

<b>I</b>	would grumble
<b>you</b>	would grumble
<b>he/she/it</b>	would grumble
<b>we</b>	would grumble

### Conditional perfect

<b>I</b>	would have grumbled
<b>you</b>	would have grumbled
<b>he/she/it</b>	would have grumbled
<b>we</b>	would have grumbled
<b>you</b>	would have grumbled
<b>they</b>	would have grumbled

## Subjunctive

### Present subjunctive

<b>I</b>	grumble
<b>you</b>	grumble
<b>he/she/it</b>	grumble
<b>we</b>	grumble
<b>you</b>	grumble
<b>they</b>	grumble

### Past perfect subjunctive

<b>I</b>	had grumbled
<b>you</b>	had grumbled
<b>he/she/it</b>	had grumbled
<b>we</b>	had grumbled
<b>you</b>	had grumbled
<b>they</b>	had grumbled

<b>I</b>	would be grumbling

<b>we</b>	would be grumbling

### Conditional perfect progressive

<b>I</b>	would have been grumbling
<b>you</b>	would have been grumbling
