### Present perfect

<b>we</b>	have played

### Past perfect

### Future

<b>you</b>	are playing
<b>he/she/it</b>	is playing
<b>we</b>	are playing
<b>you</b>	are playing
<b>they</b>	are playing

### Past continuous

<b>I</b>	was playing
<b>you</b>	were playing
<b>he/she/it</b>	was playing
<b>we</b>	were playing
<b>you</b>	were playing
<b>they</b>	were playing

### Present perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	have been playing
<b>you</b>	have been playing
<b>he/she/it</b>	has been playing
<b>we</b>	have been playing
<b>you</b>	have been playing
<b>they</b>	have been playing

### Past perfect continuous

<b>I</b>	had been playing
<b>you</b>	had been playing
<b>he/she/it</b>	had been playing
<b>we</b>	had been playing
<b>you</b>	had been playing

### Future continuous
